Digitalisation of Heritage – facts and figures

- Cultural tourism represents up to 40% of all tourism in Europe
- More than 8 million people are employed by the cultural and creative industries, through 1.2 million firms - 99.9% of which are SMEs
- European Commission has published a recommendation on a common European data space for cultural heritage to accelerate the digitisation of cultural heritage assets.
- Encourages MS by 2030 to digitise all monuments and sites that are at risk of degradation and half of those highly visited by tourists
