☐ the first initiative in lasi that collects old and used materials from the community in order to

reuse them











Four categories of green products are being created in our

workshop

☐ Repurposed/Upcycled

hundreds of products have been created out of old textiles and old clothes that cannot be reused:

- -reusable bags made from men's shirts
- -wall organized made from blue jeans
- -kitchen ware
- -decorations
- -accessories and other









□ Redesigned

the leftovers of materials we collect from local factories (the remains from their production processes) are being used for creation of new pieces of clothing through redesign

Three redesigned collections

have been created during the first year with the coordination of our partner and friend Lisbeth Lovbak Berg aka LLB, slow fashion designer













□ Recycled

inspired by a grass roots organization from Norway - FREDENSBORGER - that fundraised over 100 000 euros for projects in Sub Saharan Africa by selling recycled t-shirts

we have recycled old T-shirts and jackets that we have collected by rebranding them with new messages through print screenir







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□ Reused/Second Hand - clothes reintroduced in circuit through:

- Charity Bazars events aimed at fundraising by exchanging the donations of items received with donations of money for community projects
- Donations for vulnerable people (families with precarious incomes, people without shelter and refugees) that we approached directly or through other community initiatives



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


The approaches behind REDU


